Our Services in Los Angeles

T.R.U.E. Program WEHO (TRANSFORMING RESOURCES UNVEILING EXCELLENCE)

Our T.R.U.E program is funded by the City of West Hollywood. Our program provides comprehensive services, including outreach, case management, and referrals to TGI people who live, work, go to school, or spend a significant amount of time within the City Of West Hollywood.

HIV Prevention - PrEP/PEP SERVICES

We assist clients with learning more about HIV prevention and connect them to PrEP and PEP providers. Free condom distribution is provided at our Center.

Advocacy & Policy Change

We continue to advocate and address the needs and issues of our community by working with local and national organizations and political groups to change policy at a state and local level and improve the livelihood of TGI people.

Legal Services

Our Legal Department assists clients with gender and name changes, asylum, work visas, and more. Successfully winning asylum for several clients.

The HOPE House (TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM)

Our transitional housing program offer a 6month program designed to help client save their own money and set them up for the next step in their journey. Emergency housing placement is also available.

Reentry Services

Designed to support TGI individuals being released from jails, prisons, and immigration detention centers, providing comprehensive case management services, food, transportation, rental assistance, and referrals to other external services.

CEET Program (CENTER OF EXCELLENCE FOR ELDERLY TRANS)

Our CEET Program supports senior members of the TGI community of 50 years of age or more.

Economic & Workforce Development

Our Economic and Workforce Development program provides intensive case management, internships partnership, resume building, job search assistance, food, transportation, clothing, and skillsbuilding related to entrepreneurship.

Leadership Development

Our Leadership Development program was specifically designed to provide TGI individuals with the tools to successfully advocate for policy change at a state and national level.

promote economic development opportunities for Trans Latin@s.


Influence, policy and advocacy


