Westlake Participants

- Average median income of \$17,000 compared to the overall average for Westlake of \$32,375
- 95% are renters paying over 50+% of their income to housing costs
- BIPOC Communities: 94% Hispanic/Latinx, 3% Black, 2% White, and 1% Asian
- Limited green space and access to nutritious food and resources.



Weekly community workshops focusing on mental health, chronic diseases or other topics chosen by participants.



THURSDAYS AT CCNP

Weekly nutrition classes and food distribution, providing access to education and nutritious food. Resource linkage to other CCNP programming


