

The Los Angeles Reforms for Equity and Public Acknowledgment of Institutional Racism (L.A. REPAIR) is L.A.'s first Participatory Budget pilot program. Participatory Budgeting has been used in New York City, Chicago, and over 7,000 other cities worldwide.

L.A. REPAIR distributes \$8.5 million directly to nine communities, called REPAIR Zones.

Three REPAIR Zones completed the participatory process in Spring 2023, and the winning programs include rental assistance, a new community garden, expanded after-school programming, and mobile health care services. The six REPAIR Zones highlighted on the map are currently in the participatory process.

The Peace & Healing Centers program, funded through the City of Los Angeles' Reforms for Equity and Public Acknowledgement of Institutional Racism (REPAIR) Innovation Fund, will partner with local organizations to fund community spaces for environmental, economic, and social healing.




