The City's most marginalized communities decide how to budget \$8.5 million for new programs through a direct democratic process.

Participatory Budgeting empowers the community to propose ideas, vote on proposals to fund, and implement new services and programs. Over 7,000 cities worldwide have done Participatory Budgeting, including New York City and Chicago.



So far, 3 communities decided to budget over \$3 million for expanded after-school programing in Watts, **mobile medical services** throughout Southeast LA, rental assistance in Boyle Heights, and **a new community garden** in the Valley.

In March, 6 more communities will vote on how the remaining \$5.4 million should be budgeted. Anyone 15+ years of age who lives, works, studies, or is the parent or guardian of a student in the REPAIR Zone can participate!





### PEACE & HEALING CENTERS

The Peace & Healing Centers program, funded through the City of Los Angeles' Reforms for Equity and Public Acknowledgement of Institutional Racism (REPAIR) Innovation Fund, will partner with local organizations to fund community spaces for environmental, economic, and social healing.
