The City's most marginalized communities decide how to budget **\$8.5 million for new programs** through a direct democratic process.

Participatory Budgeting empowers the community to propose ideas, vote on proposals to fund, and implement new services and programs.

Over 7,000 cities worldwide have done Participatory Budgeting, including New York City and Chicago.




So far, 3 communities decided to budget over \$3 million for expanded **after-school programing** in Watts, **mobile medical services** throughout Southeast LA, **rental assistance** in Boyle Heights, and **a new community garden** in the Valley.

In March, 6 more communities will vote on how the remaining \$5.4 million should be budgeted.

Anyone 15+ years of age who lives, works, studies, or is the parent or guardian of a student in the REPAIR Zone can participate!




