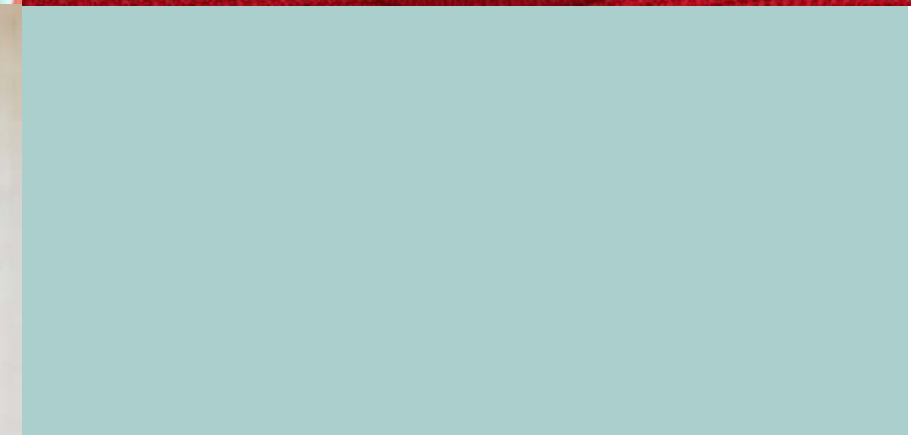

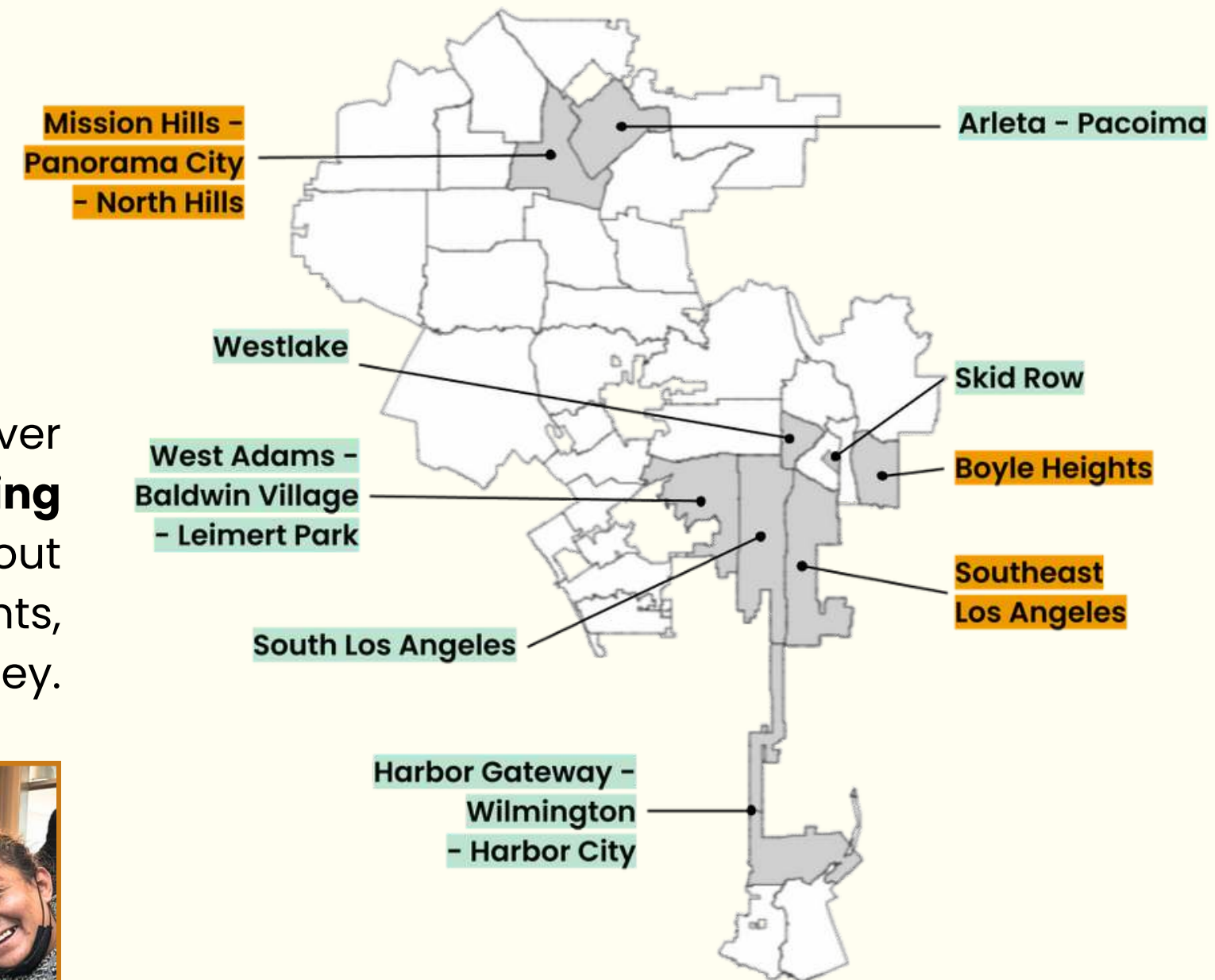
Participatory Budgeting

A program of the LA Civil Rights Department

The City's most marginalized communities decide how to budget **\$8.5 million for new programs** through a direct democratic process.

Participatory Budgeting empowers the community to propose ideas, vote on proposals to fund, and implement new services and programs. **Over 7,000 cities worldwide have done Participatory Budgeting**, including New York City and Chicago.

So far, 3 communities decided to budget over \$3 million for expanded **after-school programing** in Watts, **mobile medical services** throughout Southeast LA, **rental assistance** in Boyle Heights, and **a new community garden** in the Valley.



In March, **6 more communities will vote** on how the remaining \$5.4 million should be budgeted. **Anyone 15+ years of age** who lives, works, studies, or is the parent or guardian of a student in the REPAIR Zone can participate!

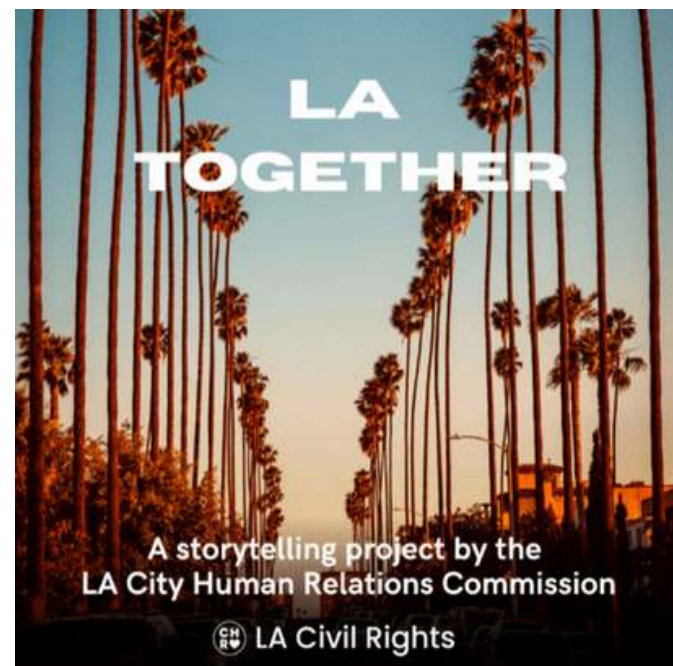
