The City's most marginalized communities decide how to budget **\$8.5 million for new programs** through a direct democratic process.

Participatory Budgeting empowers the community to propose ideas, vote on proposals to fund, and implement new services and programs.

Over 7,000 cities worldwide have done Participatory Budgeting, including New York City and Chicago.



In 2023, three communities decided to budget more than \$3 million for expanded **after-school programing** in Watts, **mobile medical services** throughout Southeast LA, **rental assistance** in Boyle Heights, and **a new community garden** in the Valley.


