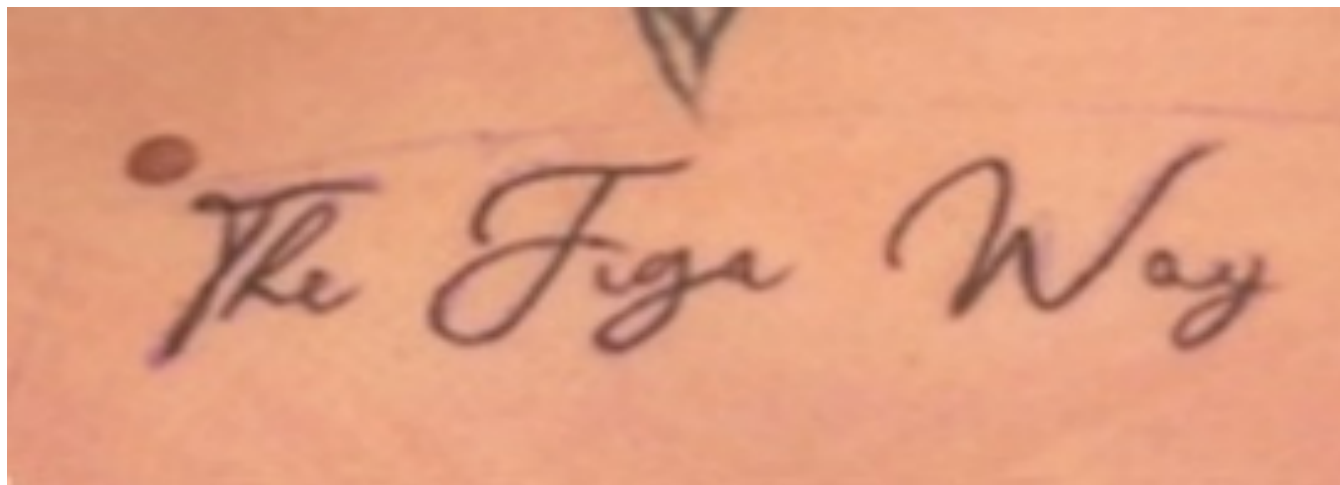

Objective

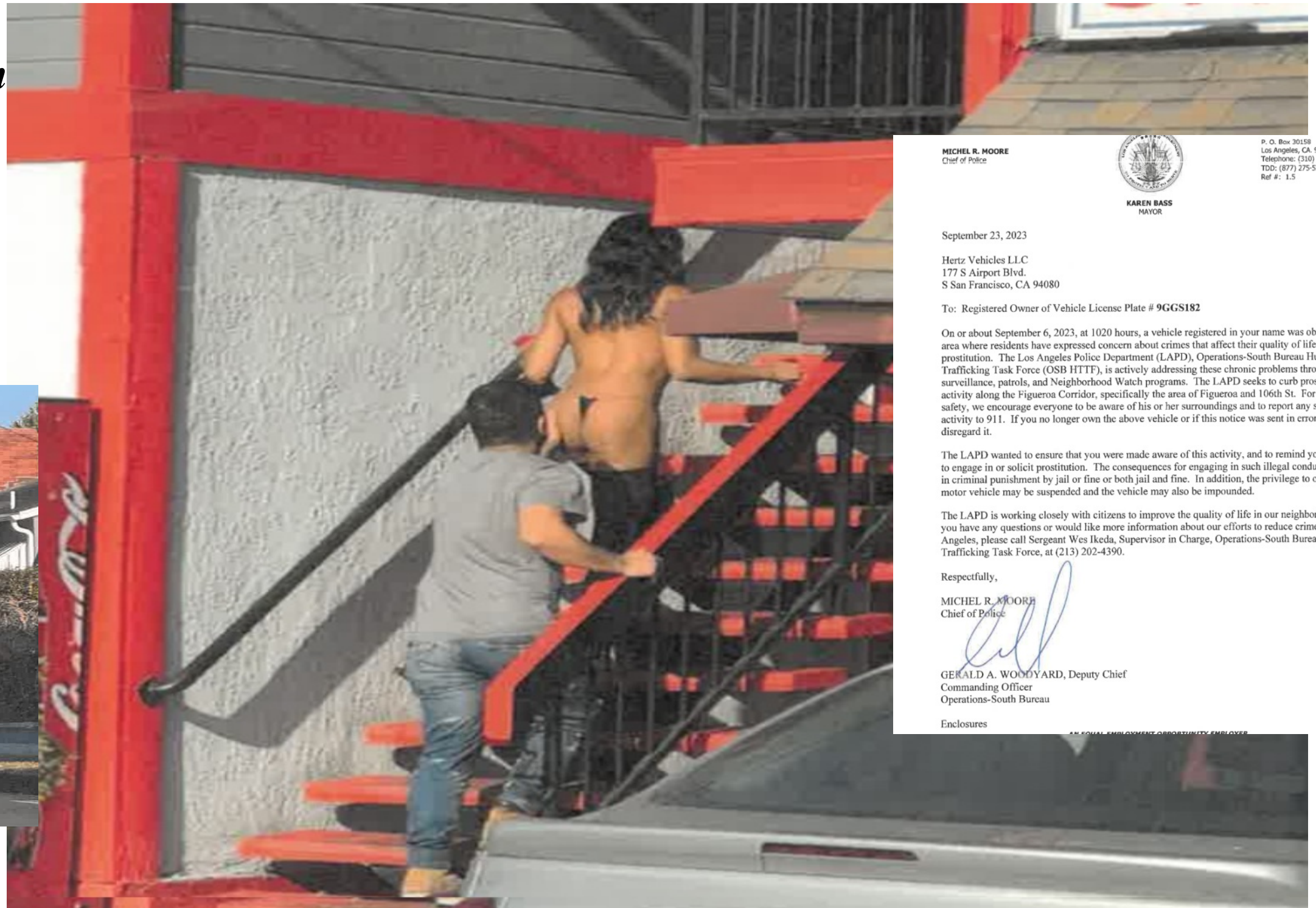
Take action against complicit motels and businesses through nuisance abatement filings, permit use revocations, etc.

On or about September 6, 2023, at 1020 hours, a vehicle registered in your name was observed in an area where residents have expressed concern about crimes that affect their quality of life, including prostitution. The Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), Operations-South Bureau Human Trafficking Task Force (OSB HTTF), is actively addressing these chronic problems through surveillance, patrols, and Neighborhood Watch programs. The LAPD seeks to curb prostitution activity along the Figueroa Corridor, specifically the area of Figueroa and 106th St. For the public's safety, we encourage everyone to be aware of his or her surroundings and to report any suspicious activity to 911. If you no longer own the above vehicle or if this notice was sent in error, please disregard it.

The LAPD wanted to ensure that you were made aware of this activity, and to remind you, it is illegal to engage in or solicit prostitution. The consequences for engaging in such illegal conduct may result in criminal punishment by jail or fine or both jail and fine. In addition, the privilege to operate a motor vehicle may be suspended and the vehicle may also be impounded.

The LAPD is working closely with citizens to improve the quality of life in our neighborhoods. 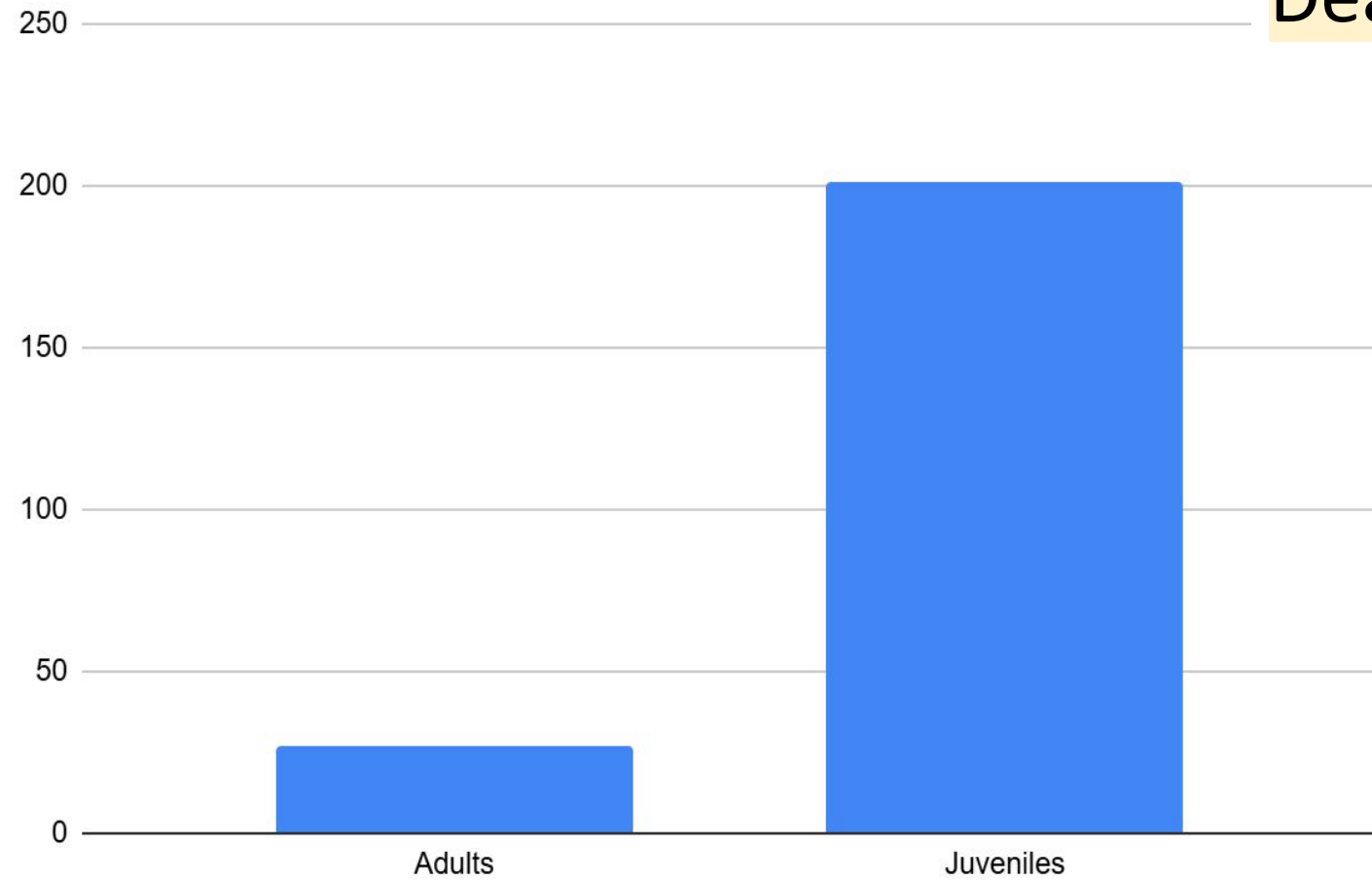

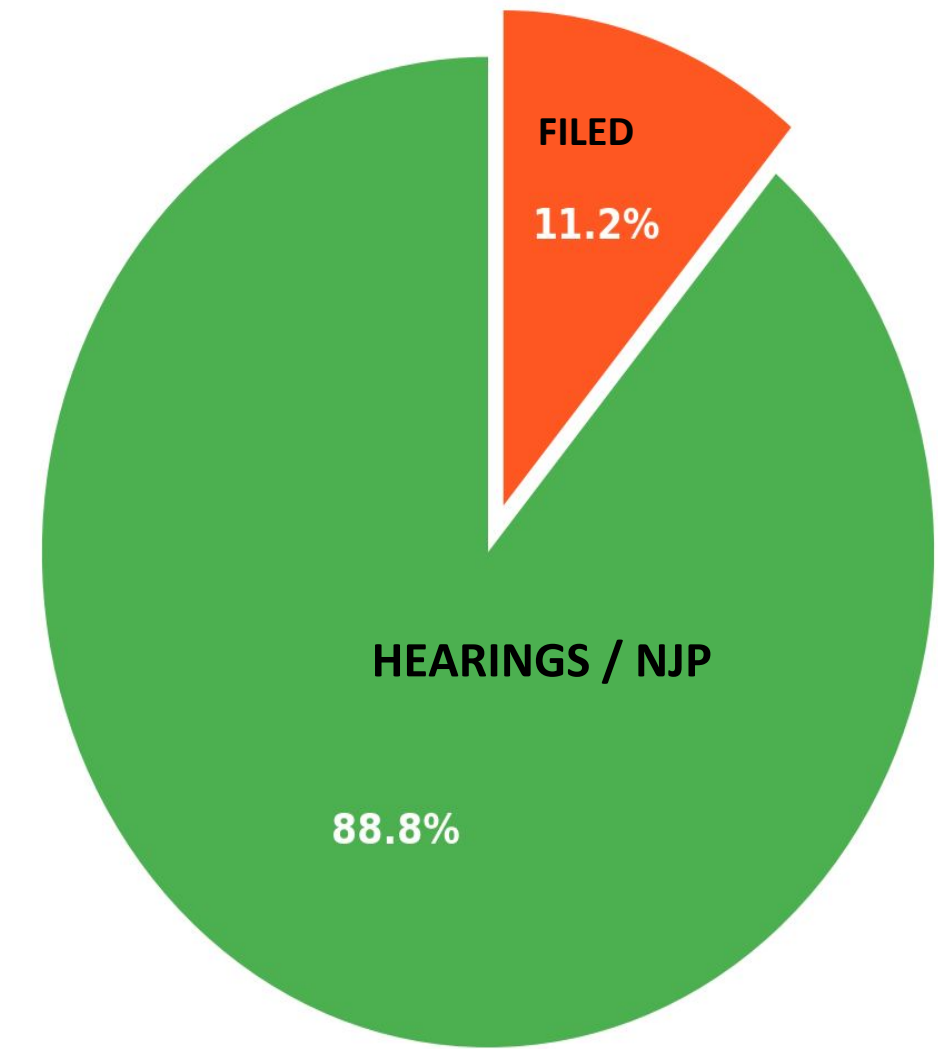
